We do not emphasize sobriety but help individuals in uncovering their weaknesses by providing them with the tools and guidance necessary to overcome addiction, maximize their potential, and thrive in life.

## BELIEF

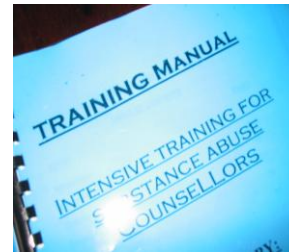

The facility is a two-level, 5,000 square foot complex that has self-contained apartments.



Each apartment has two bedrooms which sleep two individuals each.

There is a limited library with self-help books and books on addiction (we would love to see this library better endowed).



There is a dining area and kitchen where meals are provided.



Views from the apartments are of the beauty of the countryside with lush greenery all around.

The center is located in Kiambu, Kenya just twenty miles away from the capital city of Nairobi. There is public matatu service within walking distance of the complex.

In 2007 a Community Launch invited the community to raise funds and get them involved with this local ministry. "Graduates"



were presented on this special day with hundreds of family and friends in attendance.

Inside the compound these young men are safe and are given a haven of hope.

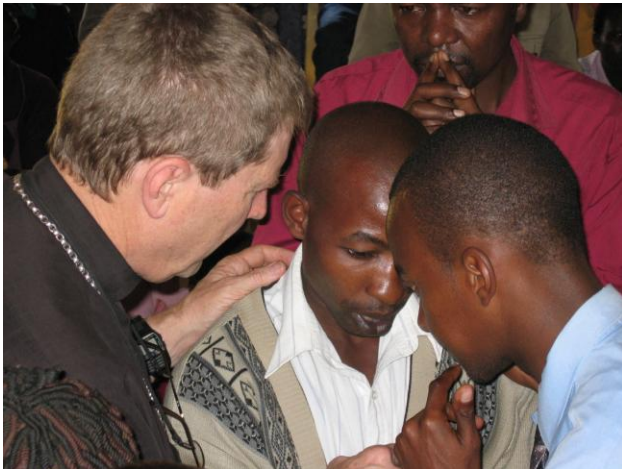


## OUR VISION

## OUR MOTTO

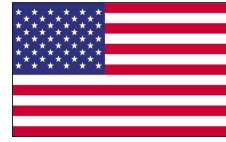
